Explanation: The Miracles Happen group offers this amendment to the motion presented on July 18, 2021 by Amy P. regarding the qualifications for groups to be added and removed from the MASC meeting schedule. We believe that adding and removing groups are two separate issues and should be treated as two motions. While we do want all willing NA groups in our geographical area to be listed on our schedule, we believe that an anonymous request made by an unknown individual via an unknown method is not a strict enough requirement to keep anyone from anywhere from requesting that any kind of meeting, NA or otherwise, be listed on our schedule. There must be some sort of protecting procedure in place.

Therefore, we offer this amendment to the first part of the original motion: (IV. C. will remain intact, becoming IV. C. 1.)

IV. C. 2. Any NA group inside or within 100 miles of the Mountain Area borders is welcome to be included on the MASC meeting schedule provided that a Group Service Representative (GSR) attends a MASC meeting, requests to be included on the meeting schedule, and agrees to abide by the Six Points.

To address part 2, schedule removal, we offer this amendment:

IV. F. By request any group may forfeit their group membership from the Mountain Area or inclusion in the meeting schedule. Forced membership or meeting schedule removal requires a motion and a two-thirds majority vote from GSRs in attendance at the MASC meeting at the time when the motion is presented.
