Regional Committee Member Report

Hello Mountain Area Service Committee,

I was able to virtually attend the most recent Volunteer Region Service Committee. Also attending from the Mountain Area was Greg V. as the delegate to the zone. Rick M. our RCM-Alt was not present.

News from around the Volunteer Region

- VRC 43, will be held in Memphis. \$20,000 in seed money has been given to the committee which estimates total costs to be \$32,000. The committee has estimated that the convention will generate \$30,000 in revenues. The \$2,000 shortfall will be made up with fundraisers. The \$20,000 in seed money will be returned to the VRSC. Side note: Room blocks – 50 Friday, 75 Saturday; 300 planned registrations; Merch to sell at 2x cost.
- Discussion around VRC42 losses were held which brought up issues related to: changing venues to centrally located cities (Nashville, Murfreesboro); changing the dates away from Thanksgiving; establishing longer-term positions (2-year chairs, hotel liaisons/negotiators, merchandise & marketing). Our task, as the Mountain Area, is to make recommendations for change for me to take back to the VRSC.
- Action items in the planning stages include: Creating an attractive service environment; Conversion to a Fellowship Development service structure (combined structure of services); and Sponsorship workshop to be held during next regional service weekend.
- The following individuals were elected to hold regional service positions: luvina B. – Policy Chair; Dameron G. – Alt. Treasurer; Mike W. – PR Chair; Preston W. - Outreach Chair; James B. – Region Secretary; Josh F. – VRC 44 (2026 – Murfreesboro)
- Regional treasury operating balance est. ~ \$12,000. (kept this amount because that's what VRC has budgeted for expenses.
- Regional H&I chairperson position is open.
- Nominations: Craig G. – Regional Delegate Alternate; Ken C. – Alternate Secretary
