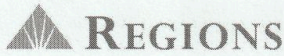


Today I will need to get the group input on the question of the YouTube Channel as it was posed to you all at last months meeting.


