## Regional Committee Member Report

May17, 2026

Hello Mountain Area service Committee,

I traveled to Murfreesboro, Tennessee on May 2nd to attend the VRSC on May 3rd. I stayed in the hotel in which the VRSC was scheduled to meet. I did receive the discounted rate offered to the VRSC members staying at the hotel. I will be requesting from this body reimbursement of \$55.00 for the balance of my hotel expense. The VRSC has reimbursed me \$100.00 towards the hotel cost and 0.40 per mile travel expense.

The total amount received from VRSC was \$279.00. Please find hotel invoice, attached to my request.

There were 9 of 10 groups present and quorum was met. (2/3rds required, 8)

I have attached a copy of the report I submitted to the VRSC to be included in the minutes here.

The issue of Regional Liability Insurance was discussed and the Region has made no progress with this. I did speak with the Vice Chair personally and we will be working together to explore a Regional policy through the Talley Insurance Group in Morristown. My efforts with the Liability policy are on going as the underwriter continues to review our submission for coverage.

The motion regarding the YouTube Channel was unanimously agreed upon at this meeting. The channel will remain up and content will continue to be uploaded to the channel.

There was also a motion to Discontinue and close down the Regional News letter due to a lack of having an editor and lack of submissions for publication in the newsletter.

Our Regions participation in the CAT/CAR process was very low. Of the 258 groups listed in our Region, only 35 participated. This is of concern at the Regional Service Committee. I have provided each of the GSRs in attendance to day with a 5 question survey to explore what we can do to better serve the groups and encourage more participation. Please, review these questions with your home group and return to me at the ASC next month. I am also attaching the reports from our Regional Delegate and Alternate RD. There is IMPORTANT information in them that is quite lengthy.

As the weather warms up, many of the Areas in our Region are planning activities. I will be submitting their flyers to our Areas' calendar, so be sure to look for up coming events on our calendar, as well as the Regional Events Calendar.

Things are going well in the Mountain Area.

Currently, there are 43 meetings per week in our Area. This represents an increase of 8 meetings per week since December of 2025.

Our Activities committee has many events being planned each month through the end of the year.

Speaker Jams, Camp Outs, Rafting trip, Halloween event, Thanksgiving, and New Years events. As flyers become available, I will submit them to the Regional Calendar.

Report:

Since our last VRSC meeting in February, the Delegate team along with the assistance of others has done multiple in-person and virtual CAR presentations as well as a CAT presentation. Our votes have been tallied and we are prepared to present them at the World Service Conference this week. Our turn out for votes has been similar to other Regions. With the recently updated groups in our Region we have 258 groups that hold 478 weekly meetings, we did have a total of 35 groups vote, thank you to all that participated. This group count does not take into account our commitment to H&I facilities.

A welcome to the Tennessee Valley Area, please advise if any assistance is needed

If we receive any updated information on the Southern Zonal Forum we will post it when available.

Good morning Volunteer Region from the World Service Conference!

As Greg mentioned in his RD report, Greg and I, along with some additional help a couple of times, held CAR workshops for 8 of the 11 Areas in the Region. We asked someone to tag in for us for another Area's CAR workshop, and two Areas had someone else facilitate theirs. Greg and I also facilitated a CAT workshop as well. Excluding Chattanooga and North Central Tn Areas from the count, we had approximately 120 people show up for the 4-5 hour workshops. I mention that number because even though that many people spent a good amount of time at those workshops, we still only had 35 of the 258 groups within the Region vote. This is not mentioned as an attempt to govern the groups or to shame those who did not vote. I am mentioning this because no matter how much we tried, it still seems like we missed the mark somehow in informing our members on the importance of the CAR. What would really benefit us in the future would be to find out why the groups that didn't vote or participate, made that decision. We are sending a brief questionnaire for every GSR to fill out letting us know their reason for not participating in the CAR/CAT process. We are looking for what we can do differently, not what the groups should do differently. RCMs, PLEASE hand these out at your Area meeting to all the GSRs and then pick them right back up at the same Area meeting! Although this information will help our Region out in the future, Greg and I are sharing this idea at the Conference so other Regions around the world can do the same thing. A very small percentage of the groups around the world are participating in the decision-making mechanism that affects our entire fellowship! Our literature may end up changing and only a small number of people will be making those types of decisions. Please share this to the groups in your Area.

Now on to the actual vote tallies. Greg submitted our Region's votes after receiving some clarity from NAVS on the amendments. If you haven't heard this before, this is a completely new process that is being tested during this Conference. One of the new things being tested is the 80% consensus for or against a motion straw poll rule. As of this conference, any motion that receives 80% consensus in favor of a motion, or less than 20% in favor of a motion (which is considered consensus against), no discussion will be held on that motion, and the initial straw poll will result in the motion being carried or stricken with consensus. Any motion not meeting that threshold will be put on the agenda for discussion at the Conference. This process is intended to cut back on the amount of time needed for discussion at the Conference on CAR and CAT motions, and allow more time for discussions on possibly more topics than the Conference has been able to have before. The list of CAR motions that did not reach the 80% consensus threshold and will be discussed at the Conference are motions 3, 3-a1, 3-a2, 3-a4, motion 4, motion 5-a1 and 5-a2, but NOT motion 5. The only CAT motions that did not reach the 80% consensus are motions 12 and 18.

What does this all mean? Well, good question and I'm glad you asked! Some of you may be aware of this from previous experience, and some of you may be catching on now, but just because our groups vote, that does not mean that is the final word. Although our groups are supposed to be the final authority, this current process does not seem to bear that out. Also, this process does not really allow for the lone voice to be heard. Hang with me for just a second here. Here is the basic breakdown of the current process. First, the World Board, and now rarely a Region, will make a motion(s) to be presented in the CAR and the only people that have input on the wording (and basically just the wording) is the World Board. Next, the World Board sends the motion(s) out between Thanksgiving and Christmas in the CAR, which is basically 5-6 months before the World Service Conference. Then all the Regions, Areas, and groups around the world workshop it based on the information that the World Board prepares. Somewhere between these workshops and the new voting deadline, groups from around the world vote on the motion(s). Then, after all the groups votes are tallied, the Regional Delegates from around the world gather to discuss the motion(s) that

the groups have already voted on, which now only includes the ones that don't reach the 80% consensus threshold, and then the Delegates may or may not change the outcome of the group's votes based on the discussion held at the Conference. This seems to be problematic in a few different ways.

I want to add that there are numerous Delegates who have spoken up about this process and do not like that the lone voice is not being heard. I am bringing it here because we are going to be discussing it this week and it will benefit Greg and I to have any thoughts or input our Region may have. And to be clear, there are two processes here that seem to be problematic. First, the discussion on a motion happens only with the Delegates, and after the groups have already voted. This order does not allow the groups to get the information needed to vote intelligently and our 8th Concepts states that "A conscience fed on ignorance is an ineffective conscience, incapable of providing reliable guidance," yet this is the process we follow at the NA World Service Conference on matters that affect our global fellowship. The second issue is that even though this is the current process we follow, the new process of 80% consensus in the straw poll determining the outcome of a motion does not allow the Delegates to hear why the minority of Regions voted against a motion, which may sway their vote. Now that brings another issue to the surface. We ask all the groups from around the world to vote, yet the person we elect to represent our Regions has the apparent power and authority to change the vote of an entire Region based on new or different information at the Conference.

I want to point out that this entire process and event that is the NA World Service Conference is something way more complicated than putting on a speaker meeting and a dance! The logistics involved in making this happen are globally challenging at the least. Travel visas are required and that usually requires NAVS to write request letters to get the Delegates approved. Lodging, meeting space, travel, and food are managed for a lot of Delegates from around the world. Facilitating a meeting with 250 people in it and trying to have as much discussion as possible, yet still not take advantage of everyone's time. Managing all the technological issues such as zoom and the voting clickers. Many members participate virtually now and may be in a time zone that is up to 12-hours away. And then having to hear all the complaints that people have from around the world, especially from those of us who think or have thought we know everything, yet still try to be as spiritual as possible to ensure our service structure stay true to our principles. That's a huge undertaking and I do not downplay the role the World Board and NAVS have in making all of this come to fruition, with most members still only putting a dollar in the basket! I want to be clear that I am in full support of NAVS, the World Board, and more importantly, Narcotics Anonymous around the world. However, we also have a responsibility to speak up, share our ideas and conscience, and sometimes hold our trusted servants accountable, in a loving way.

I don't know what the best course of action is, other than starting with my Region and pointing out what others and I see as some of the challenges of our current voting processes at the World Service Conference. I would love to hear what thoughts and ideas you all may have that we may present as possible solutions.

On a final note, I am super excited to be here and will be doing my best to send out a daily blurb of sorts about what's taking place here! Thanks so much for taking the time to listen to such a lengthy report, but I'm just getting you guys warmed up for the one coming in August! Thanks for allowing me to serve the Volunteer Region of Narcotics Anonymous!
